The first days of school we will hold a Falcon Camp for **all** students. During this camp they will learn school wide expectations, get textbooks, and new students will have tours of the building. 

Immunization Requirements

Immunization requirements for incoming 7th graders...

- * Second Varicella (documented history of the chicken pox disease will suffice)
- * Meningitis vaccine
- *Tdap vaccine given within the last 5 years

Parents, please be aware that students who do not have a current immunization record on file, in the clinic, will not be allowed to pick up their schedule or books or attend classes until a current immunization record has been turned in...no exceptions. If you have not already done so, please submit a copy of your child's updated immunization record as soon as possi-

<u>Students who require medication while at school</u> - Parents, please do not send medication to school, with your child, and expect them to bring it to the clinic. All medication needs to be brought to the clinic by a parent and the appropriate paperwork needs to be filled out and signed, by you, before any medication will be given. Also, all medication must be in the original container and can not be expired.



Fort Settlement MS -2012-2013 Volleyball News

- *Tryouts for 7th & 8th graders will be held on August 28, 29, & 30.
- *Attendance is required for all three days from 3:50 pm to 5:50pm.



Some practices will be 7am to 8:15am and some will be 4pm to 5:45pm. We practice Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thurs. Most of our games are played on Thursday.

The UIL policy states that all students involved in athletic tryouts must have a physical examination from a doctor. Physical forms are located on the www.fortbend.k12.tx.us web page. Click on Athletics to obtain the physical forms.

A completed physical form must be returned to the *PE office* by <u>Aug. 27th (first day of school).</u>

<u>IT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED TO KEEP A COPY OF THE PHYSICAL AT HOME</u>. We have experienced students losing their physical on the way to school and as a result were unable to tryout. This physical will be current for one calendar year from the actual physical date.

We will select twenty-four athletes per grade level. Good luck to all.

Football Season

Attention 7th and 8th grade football parents:

Football starts the first day of school on August 27. All of your equipment will be provided by Fort Bend I.S.D. and equipment checkout will be from 4:00 – 6:00 PM on August 15, in the boys' locker room at FSMS. This equipment checkout is not mandatory, and there is no makeup date, if missed the athletes will get their equipment on the first day of school. The athletes can provide their own shoes and helmets, but if you want to use your own helme



athletes can provide their own shoes and helmets, but if you want to use your own helmet, you must provide a doctor's note and we have to inspect the helmet to insure it is safe. It must not be more than 7 years old and it must have a NOCSAE seal stamped on it. (Bring your completed physical form at that time).

You must have a physical exam form turned in to the Fort Settlement coaches before you can participate. One physical is good for all sports for one calendar year. You will be expected to be present and on time for all games and practices. We practice every day after school, 4:00-5:45 PM. Everyone will be placed on either the "A" or "B" team. A copy of the football schedule is on the FSMS weebly website.

The first four days of school the boys will need a pair of athletic shorts and a shirt. There is a state mandated four day period with no pads so the boys can get acclimated to the heat. PE uniforms will be sold for \$20.00 a pair if needed.

We look forward to working with the athletes and parents of 2012 – 2013 and continuing the winning attitude and success of Fort Settlement Falcon Athletics. Enjoy your summer and we hope to see you on the field in the fall.


Production and Information Technology

Fort Settlement Middle School prides itself on having an overall educational curriculum that rivals any school.
